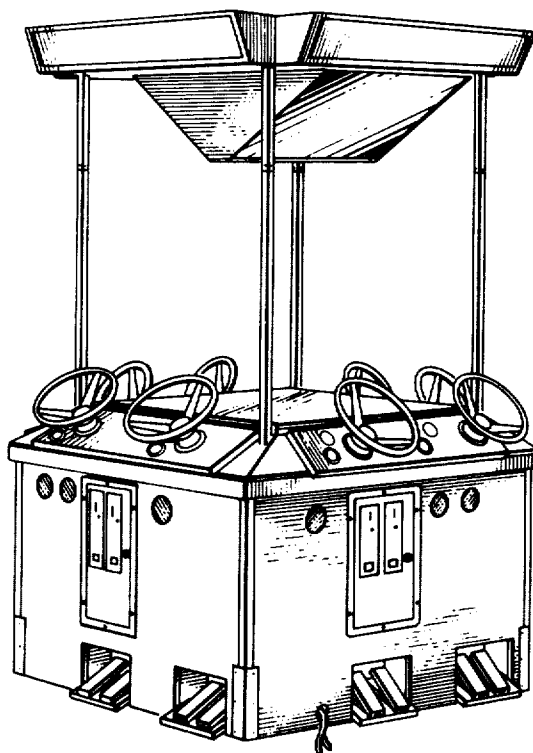

 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the right rear of FIG. 1.



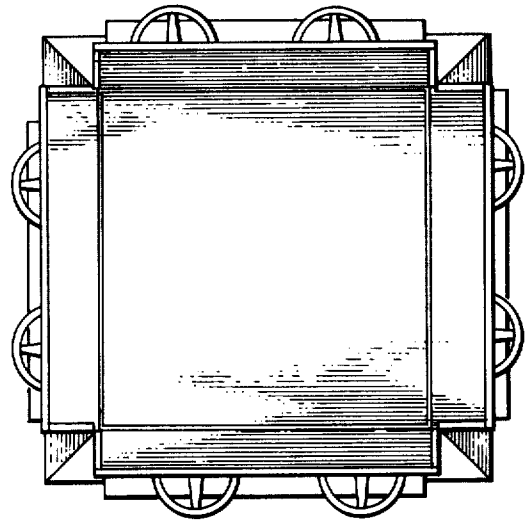
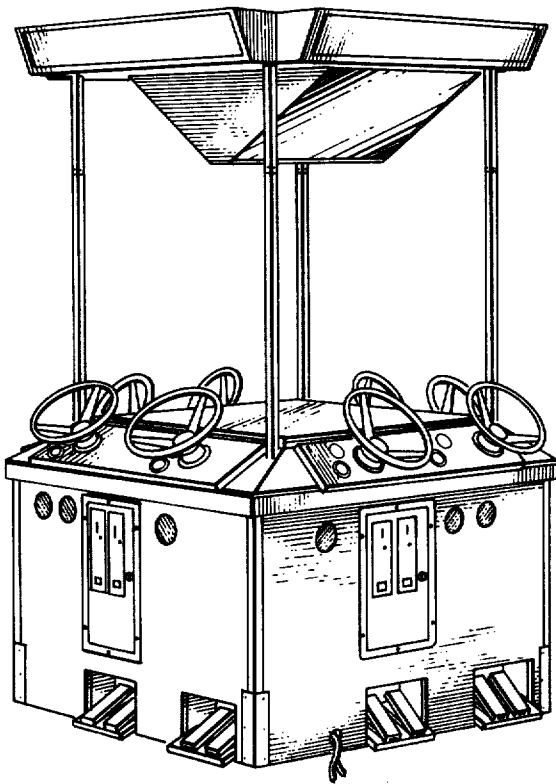

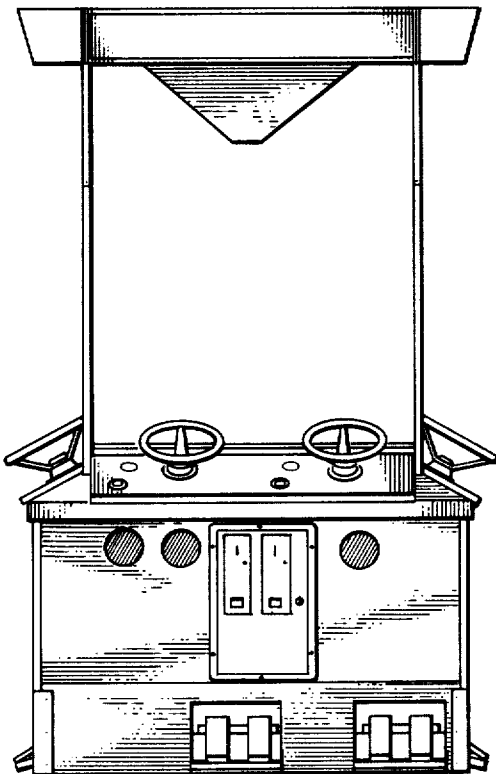
