FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof;

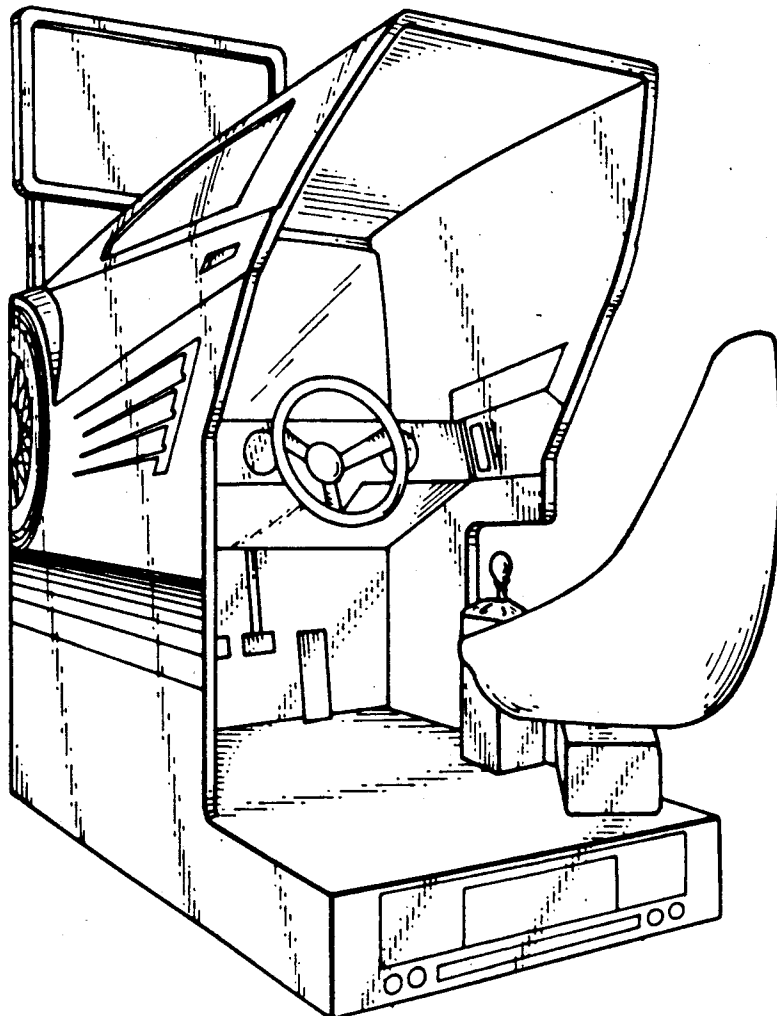
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation thereof; the right side elevation being a mirror image thereof;

The bottom surface is plain and unornamented.



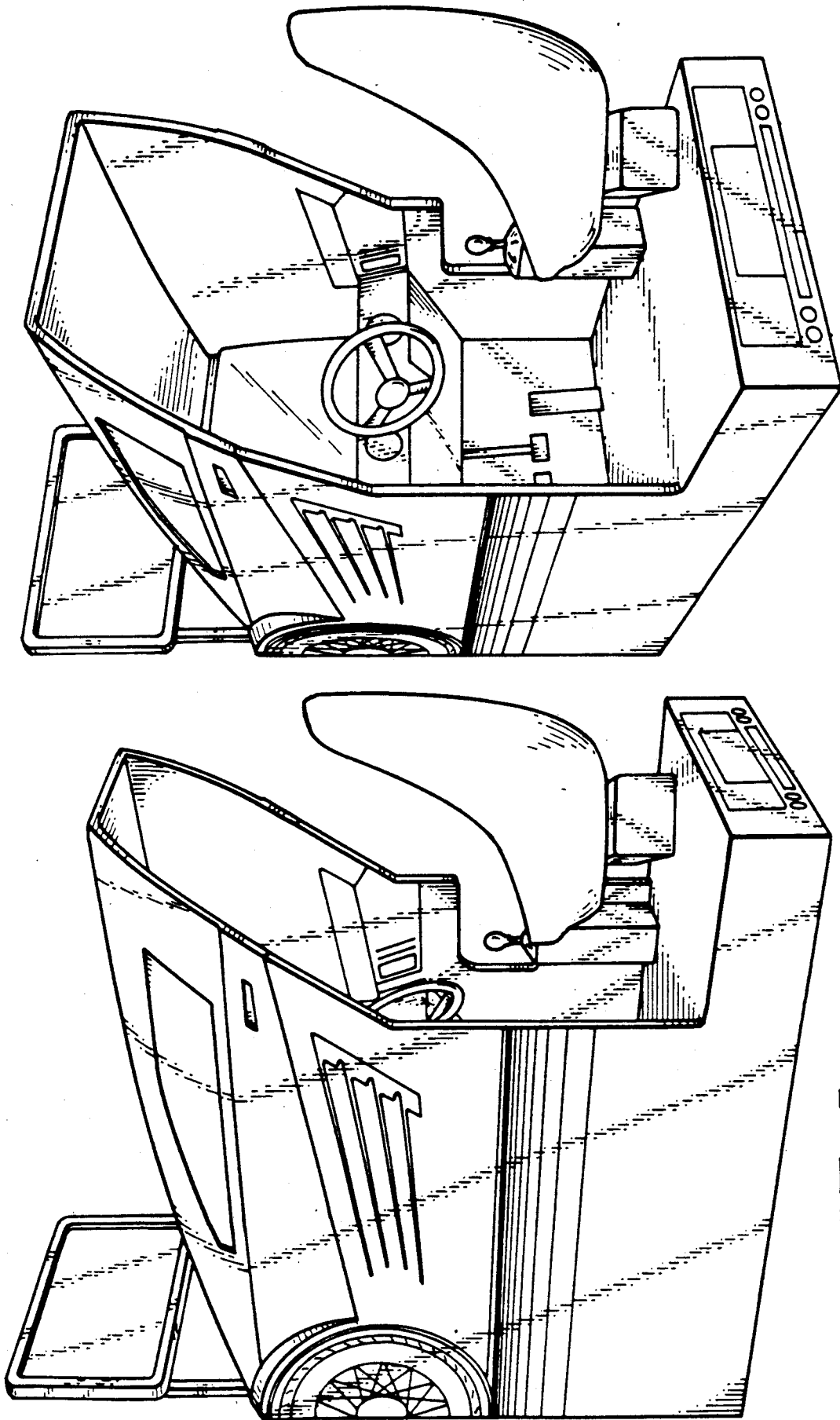

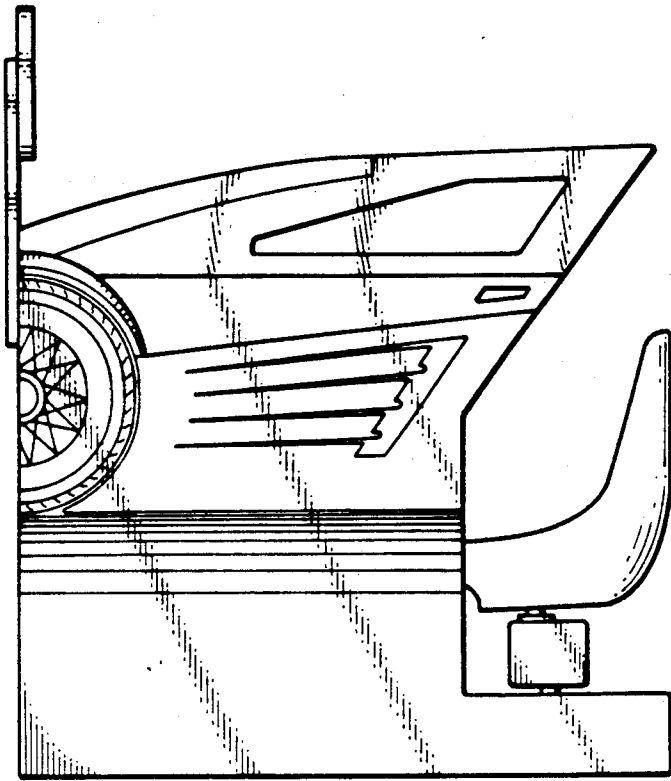

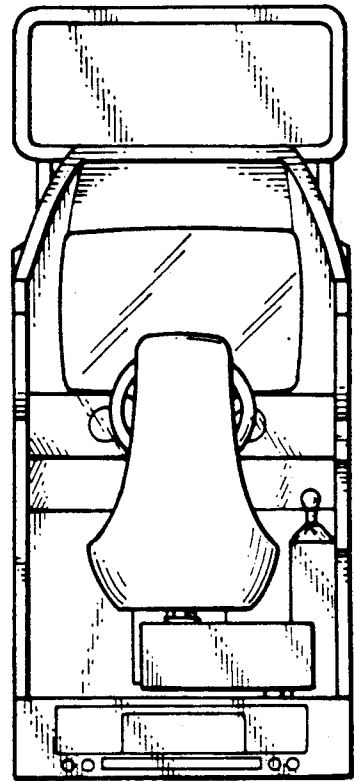

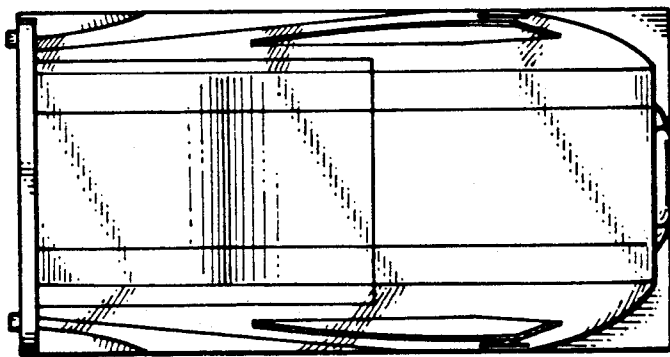
