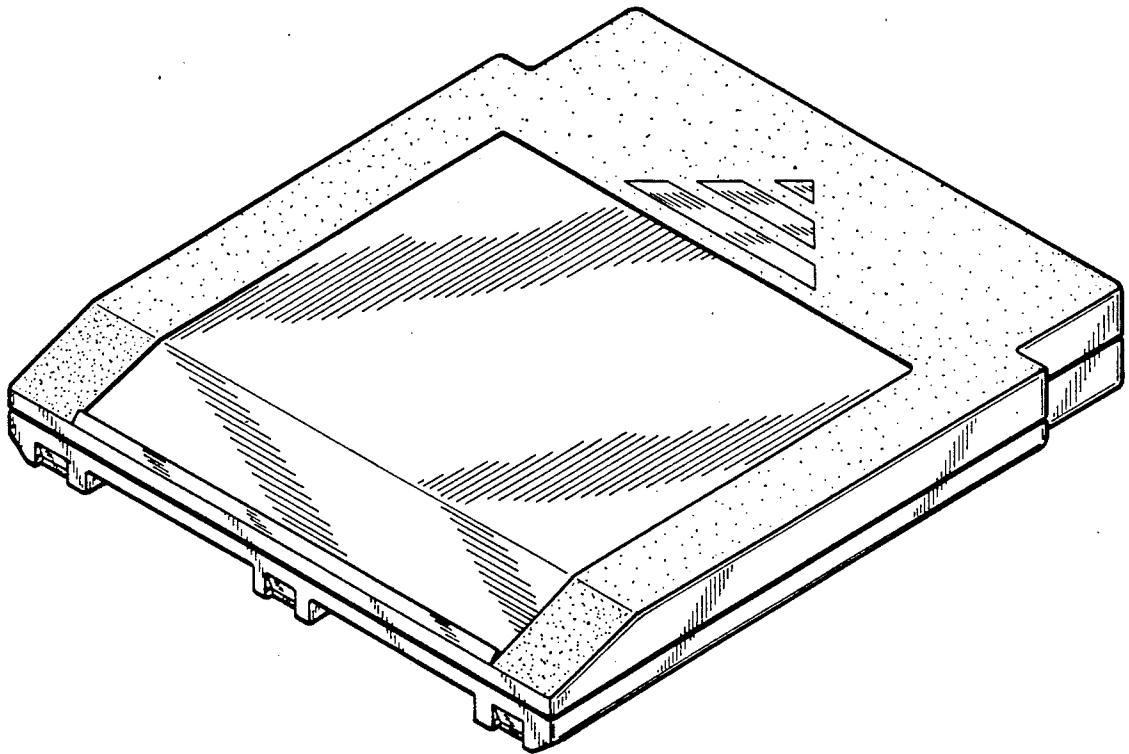

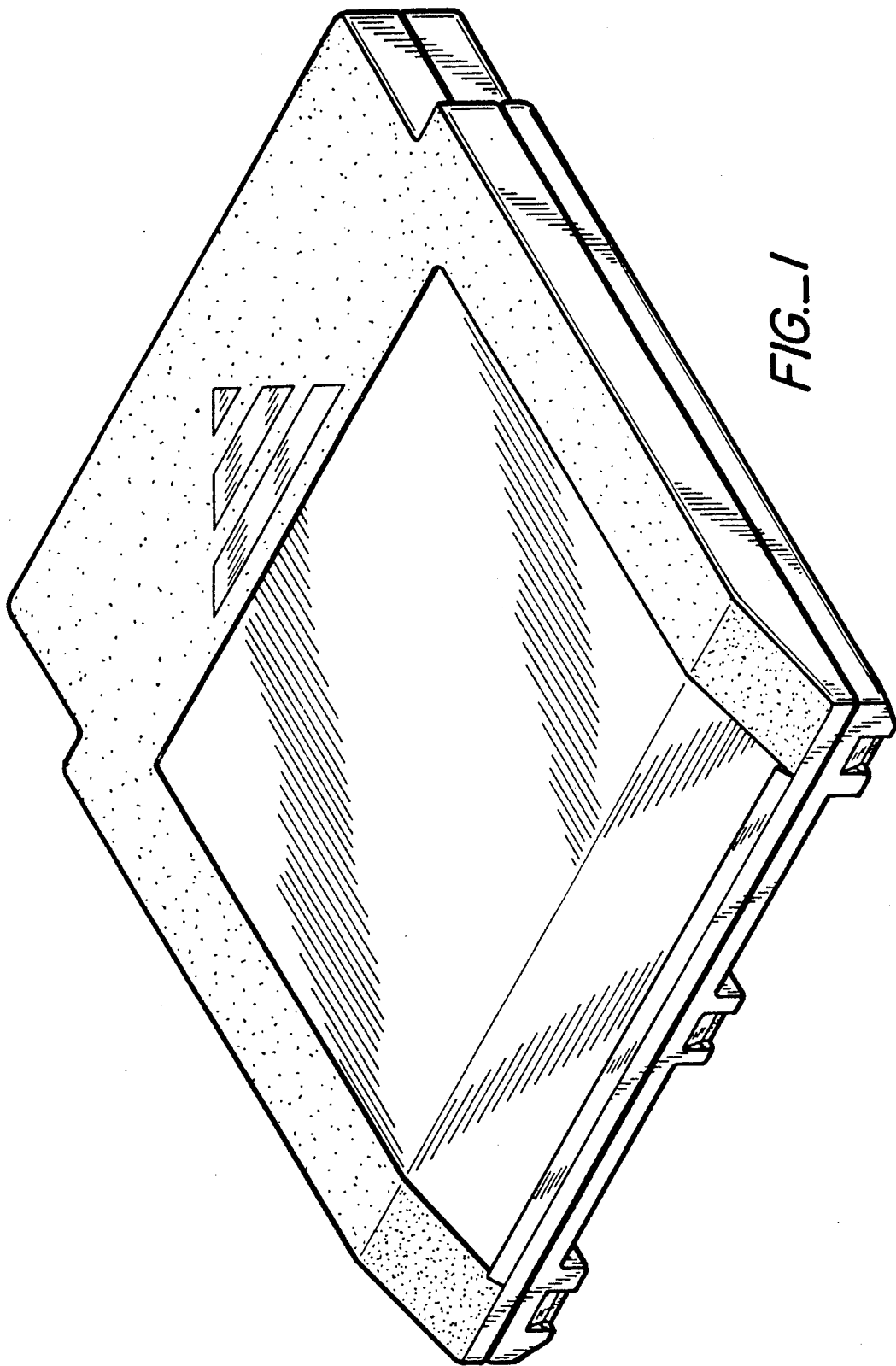
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a video game cartridge showing my new design;

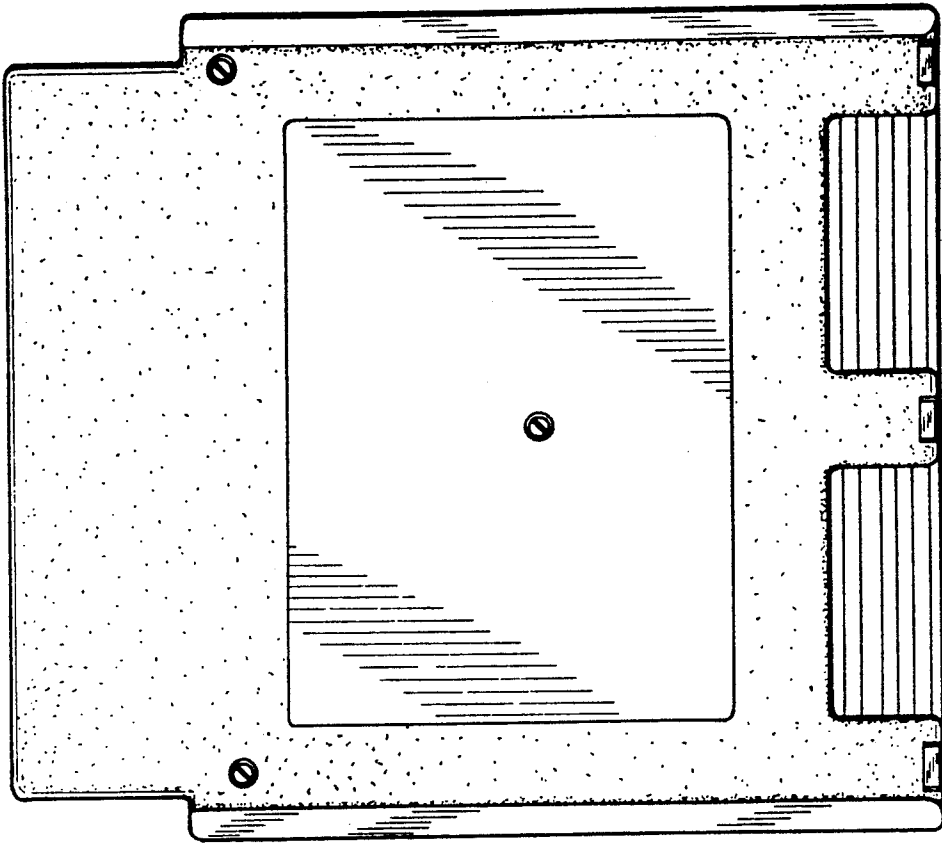

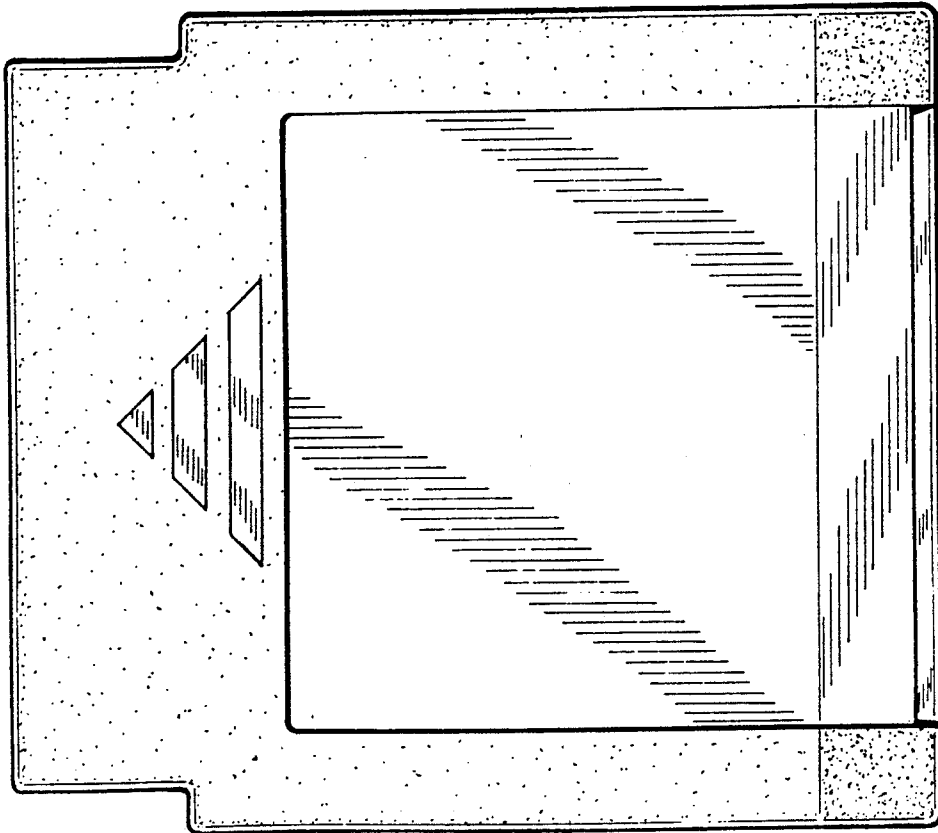

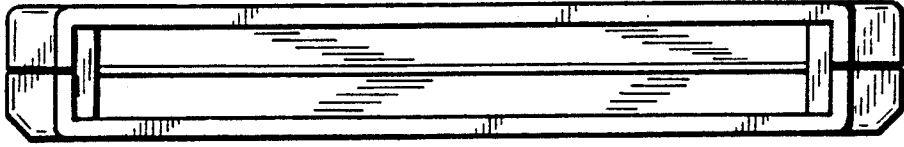

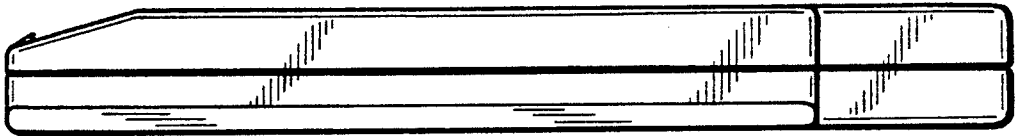
