in context

Strategies:

- Completion of documentation work of Nevada Rock Art Foundation
- minimal development
- preserve archaeological "context" by protecting viewshed and primitive feel of site
- limited recreation and interpretive services
- enforcement by public agencies, and using volunteer docents

Suggested Treatment:

All areas should be designated as "Day-Use Only," there should be no camping allowed in any of the described areas.

Zone 1 A (main petroglyph area)

" low impact signage

self-guided trail to most popular and significant petroglyphs

restricted access:

· off-trail access permitted only on scheduled tours, or scheduled times

parking areas away from main concentration area

- information kiosks and primitive toilets away from main concentration areas
- motor vehicle access limited

dogs must be leashed

no rubbings or tracings allowed of any petroglyphs

designated trails (primarily away from the rock art)

Zone 1B (midden areas)

no development on midden areas (preserve for possible future excavation)

Zone 1C (rock walls)

preserve intact

no management other than avoidance

Zone 2 (viewshed)

Zone 2A - upstream drainage to visible ridgelines

no structures within 1/2 mile of main petroglyph area

any structures within the viewshed should use design elements which minimize visual impact from the vantage of the main petroglyph concentration

Zone 2B – no manmade structures should be visible above the rim rock Zone 2C – downstream approach

Zone 3 (next drainage north)

- protection corridor along the drainage to protect several scattered concentrations of petroglyphs
- primitive hiking trail along corridor to connect sites
- minimal signage at sites to protect resource (not encourage visitation)
- unrestricted access/visitation to foot traffic
- minimal developed parking (to prevent uncontrolled parking) at trail access points
